## UPDATE

**Ngati Whakaue is no closer to being formally re-engaged with the Crown.**

Despite best efforts, including working closely with the respective Chairs of Pukeroa Oruawhata Trust and Ngati Whakaue Tribal Lands, the Crown is not prepared to re-open negotiations **unless** Ngati Whakaue agrees with the Crown's position.

You will recall Ngati Whakaue voted to reject the Crown's Offer at the 2016 AGM.

## WHERE TO FROM HERE

TKN invited all registered Wai Claimants to meet at GHA on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018.

Points Discussed:

- 1 Letter on behalf of a cohort of claimants to the Minister for Treaty Negotiations questioning TKN's mandate
- 2 Shared what efforts have been made to address the impasse between TKN and the Crown (timeline)
- 3 Gained a sense of what Claimants want TKN to do given the Crown's refusal to re-engage
- 4 Presented option/s going forward
- 5 Resolution put to the Iwi.



## VISION

Questions we need to ask ourselves: What are we working towards? Why is it important to you as a claimant and the wider Ngati Whakaue? How are we going to get there?

### CNI

TKN is your Post Settlement Governance entity (PSGE) for the CNI Settlement.

- 2 Participating in determining co-governance arrangement with Rotorua Lakes Council over the Whakarewarewa forests
- 3 Participating in the co-management of the Whakarewarewa forests (including Tokorangi)
- 4 Plan Change 10

### OUT OF SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATION

- Negotiating purchase of 546 Pah Rd Kaituna In partnership with Tapuika.
- In discussions with BOP Regional Council re long term lease of property
